

# Report on the incidents of 1 and 4 October 2017

Patients treated during the day of the referendum  
and on subsequent days as a result of State police  
charges

During the day of the referendum, 1 October 2017, as a consequence of the State police charges, 991 people were diagnosed and treated by professionals from the SEM (Emergency Medical System), CAP (Primary Healthcare Centres), PAC (Ongoing Care Facilities), CUAP (Primary Care Emergency Centres) and hospitals. Of these, 214 were treated by the SEM and 777 in health centres: in 38 hospitals, 40 CAP and PAC, and 14 CUAP.

Between 2 and 4 October 2017, 75 more people were treated in health centres.

Therefore, a total of 1,066 people were treated between 1 and 4 October in relation to the police actions.

The cases with the most serious medical diagnoses are:

- One case of heart attack (Vall d'Hebron University Hospital).
- One case of fractured orbital floor and right maxilla affecting the eyeball (Hospital de la Santa Creu and Sant Pau).
- One case of traumatic brain and abdominal injury with hypertensive emergency (Hospital Platón).
- One case of traumatic brain injury with loss of consciousness (Hospital Santa Caterina).
- One case of trauma to the right shoulder and trauma to the right trapezius muscle (Hospital de la Santa Creu and Sant Pau).

Cases of emotional disturbance related to police charges that have received treatment in the health centre network from 2 October onward are accounted for as part of the special programme of comprehensive care for people with signs of disturbance due to acute stress and post-traumatic stress disorder announced by the Catalan Health Minister on 6 October.
